In the winter of 2007, the Conference Public Information Committee was looking for an activity that we could manage and would have strong leverage for the fellowship. With some internet research, we learned that our basic text was not available in most libraries, even in major metropolitan areas. These included Chicago, San Francisco, Los Angeles, New York City, and my home city of Toronto. I conducted a pilot in Toronto, contacting the Collection Development Department of the Toronto Public Library system, and succeeded in getting six copies into circulation. We donated one, and they bought five! Let's set a goal of placing the basic SLAA text in every library in the world (one library at a time).
