Mission:

The practice of the SLAA Steps and an understanding of the Traditions are critical to recovery from sex and love addiction. As such, the mission of the Conference Steps and Traditions Committee is to provide individuals and the fellowship as a whole, with resources to deepen their understanding of the 12 Steps and 12 Traditions.

Currently, the committee accomplishes this by:

1. Assisting the Fellowship-Wide Services (FWS) office in responding to inquiries regarding the interpretation and application of the Steps and Traditions, and
2. Contributing to the creation of literature pertaining to the Steps and Traditions.

So far this year, we've considered two real-time Traditions issues via email and telephone conference and provided written responses to the inquirers regarding our thoughts on how the Traditions might apply to the situation as they described it. As well, we have considered a draft piece of literature in a similar way and provided a written response to the writer's of that document.

And, we continue to work on the 12 Steps and 12 Traditions of SLAA. Our goal this year is to collect as many sharing sheets from fellowship as we can and to develop a request for proposals so that those who might like to write and/or edit this piece of literature might apply to do so.
